



WORKFORCE TRAINING FUNDS AVAILABLE FOR SOUTH CENTRAL OREGON EMPLOYERS

- Does your company need to improve workforce skills to remain competitive?

Your company may be eligible for Employer Workforce Training Funds.

Eligibility Requirements:

Eligible companies are for-profit employers residing within Klamath and Lake counties for at least 120 days. A dollar-for-dollar cash or in-kind match is required from employer.

Funding Priorities:

Priority for funding is given to applicants who demonstrate that their proposed training program could assist the business in avoiding a layoff, downsizing or closure; or would provide retention opportunities by upgrading employee skills as a result of the training

Grant Application Process:

Grant Applications are accepted by the last day of each month starting in March, 2011. Applications are evaluated by the Workforce Response Team. The application process will stay open until funds are depleted.
