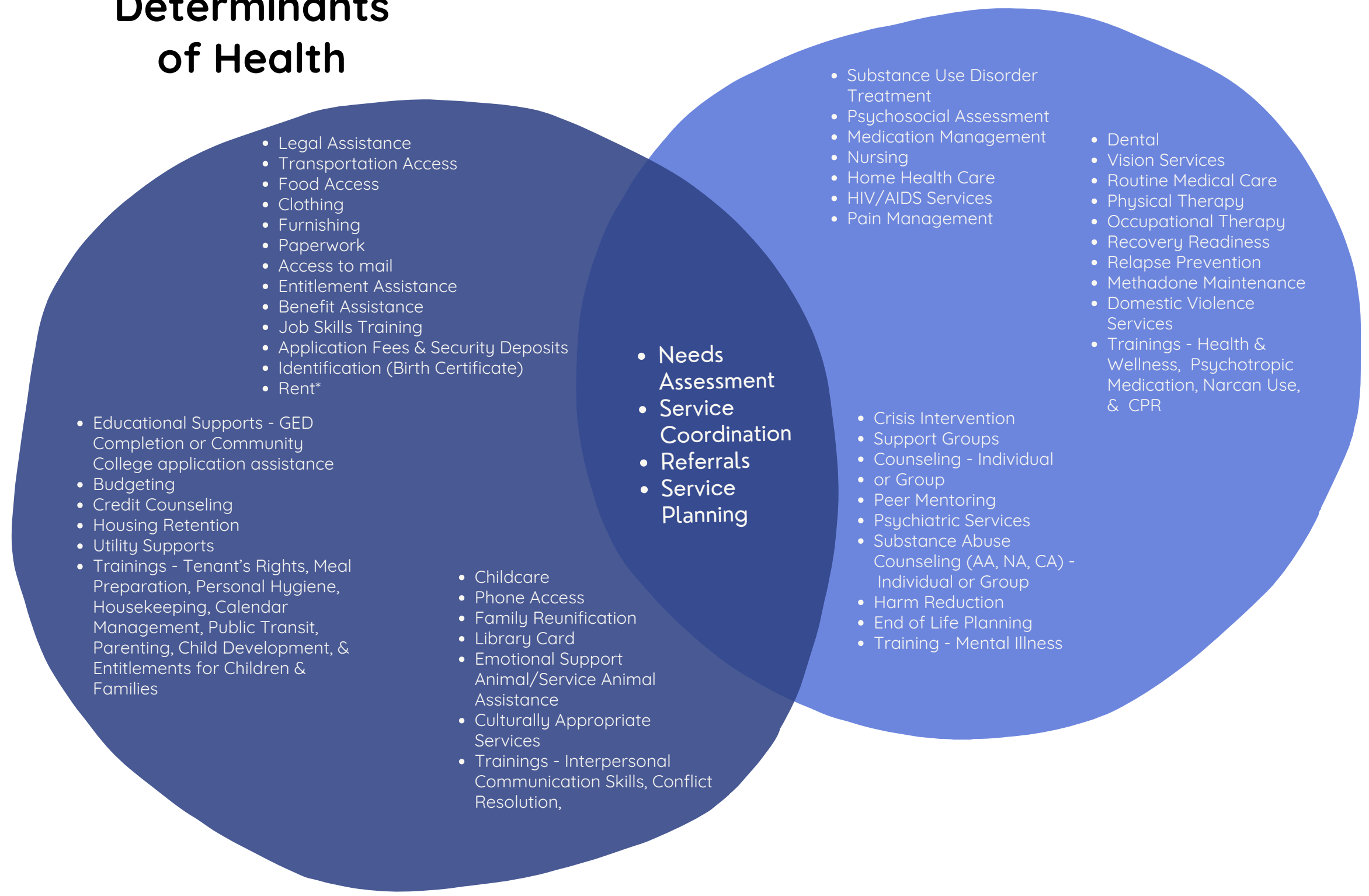

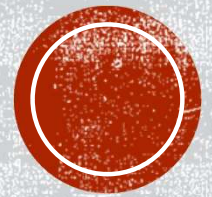

Provider Benefit Funding Application

Provider Benefit Funding allows providers to support interventions in meeting the goals as set forth in EO 23-02. Providers are eligible for funding to support households and provide additional supports to continue to serve the unsheltered homeless population in the community. OR503 has determined that it costs \$5,000** to provide wrap around services per household moving from unsheltered homelessness into housing. These funds are to support and maintain successful client housing.

Providers interested in supporting this effort and receiving funding of \$5,000 per eligible household through EO23-02 must complete this form in its entirety and return to COIC Fiscal Contact. Within 10 days of award approval, agreement will be returned to provider for acceptance of award. All households must be documented in HMIS to comply with State reporting requirements.
